Health & Safety Classes General Registration Information

Health and Safety Course Registration Policies

All registration is on a first-come, first-served basis.

You are not registered in a class until we have received your payment in full, and determined that space is available.

Payment and registration must be received at least two business days before the first day of class.

Refund Policy

If you need to cancel your enrollment in a class, a full refund, less a \$10 administrative fee (per class, per person), will be given if you notify us at least 72 hours (or three business days) prior to the first day of the class you are scheduled to attend.

If you wish to transfer to a different class, you must notify us at least 72 hours (or three business days) prior to the (first) day of the class you are scheduled to attend. Students may transfer **one** time into another class. Students who are unable to attend classes due to last-minute emergencies are handled on an individual basis.

Class Information

Please arrive on time. Late arrivals may not be admitted. Most of our courses utilize videotapes, group discussion and practice sessions. Because of these interactive training methods, students must attend all class sessions to receive certification.

Students will be required to actively participate. Please wear comfortable, loose-fitting clothing that will allow for kneeling on the floor mats as recommended.

For daylong courses, please bring a sack lunch. Pop, water and light snacks will be available for purchase.

Health Precautions

The American Red Cross follows the cleaning and decontamination guidelines set forth by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). When the guidelines are consistently followed and basic personal hygiene is practiced, the risk of any kind of disease transmission during class is extremely low.

If you have one of the following conditions, please call ahead and request a separate manikin at least 48 hours in advance to have specific accommodations made. Call (740) 772-2014:

If you have a condition that would increase other participants' risk of exposure to infections

If you have an acute condition such as a cold or a sore throat, cuts or sores on your hands or around your mouth

If you have had a positive blood test for Hepatitis B, or if you have a chronic infection of any kind

If you have a condition that would increase your risk of exposure to infections

If you have a compromised immune system as a result of HIV infection, chemotherapy, or other cause.
